With three of the lowest performing elementary and middle schools, hundreds of students will attend both elementary and middle schools ranked in the state's bottom five percent.

The high school ranks near the bottom for every metric, with only one in ten students meeting the state Ready Graduate standard. More than one third of the Hunters Lane high school students are chronically absent.
