

## KEY INSIGHTS

The Maplewood cluster is one of the lowest-performing in the district. While one school, Schwab Elementary, earned reward status, every middle and high school students in this cluster attends a priority school that ranks in the state's bottom five percent.
The percentage of middle school students scoring "on track or mastered" and the percentage of high school students considered college or career ready are similar-- hovering barely above 5\%. Almost two-thirds of Maplewood High School students are burdened with a high level of poverty. It is one of three schools in the district with a chronic absenteeism rate above 40\%.

Identified by the state as improving student achievement and growth. The top distinction a school can earn in TN. Identified by the state and fall in the bottom five percent statewide over the past three years, and are in need of the most support and improvement.
The state of Tennessee identifies a Ready Graduate as a student who graduated on time in 2017 and earned a composite ACT score of a 21 or higher, the score at which students are considered career and college ready. Students missing $10 \%$ of schools days or 18 days
\% for English and Math represent the number of students scoring "on track" or "mastered." Schools that fell below the TN state average ( $33 \%$ for both subjects) are in red and those exceeding the state average are in green.
NA Data not available. When the percentage of students is below $5 \%$, or above $95 \%$, the state suppresses the data because it could be identifiable for students. We can understand that the percentage of students "on track or mastered" is below 5 percent and therefore unavailable.
