KEY INSIGHTS

All but one school in the Whites Creek cluster is a priority school, meaning almost all the students in this cluster will attend a bottom 5% school for every year of their education.

Whites Creek High School is the lowest performing in MNPS, with the lowest average ACT score, achievement scores below 5%, the second highest chronic absenteeism rate (42%), and no score for college or career readiness.

One middle school was placed in the Achievement School District for state-led turnaround. Joelton Elementary School stands out as the only non-priority school in the cluster and because it exceeds the state student achievement average.
