Key:

- 1) **Reward School**— Identified by the state as improving student achievement and growth. Reward status is the top distinction a school can earn in Tennessee.
- 2) **Priority School** — Identified by the state and fall in the bottom five percent statewide over the past three years, and are in need of the most support and improvement.
- 3) "N/A"— When the percentage of students is below 5%, or above 95%, the state suppresses the data because it could be identifiable for students. We can understand that the percentage of students "on track or mastered" in ELA is below 5 percent and therefore unavailable. Likewise, we can understand the percentage of students chronically absent is below 5 percent.
