DATA SUMMARY

With one high, four middle, and ten elementary schools, the McGavock cluster serves over 10% of the MNPS student population. Although achievement scores for some of its elementary schools are near the state average, middle school and high school numbers fall significantly below it.

From elementary to middle school, the cluster loses 34% of its enrolled students. At the high school level, the graduation rate (79.4%) is slightly lower than most MNPS high schools. And although 31% of graduates are considered college or career ready, student achievement scores measure around half that number - or less.
