DATA SUMMARY

Home to two Reward schools, the Stratford cluster includes one of the highest-performing zoned elementary schools in the district. Another Reward elementary school in this cluster, KIPP Kirkpatrick, is operated by a charter network as part of a turnaround partnership with MNPS. The cluster has two schools on the Priority list.

Stratford STEM Magnet, a combined high/middle school, has one of the highest suspension rates in the district, with almost 27% of students suspended at least once. In measures of college and career readiness, the school falls in the bottom quartile of all MNPS zoned high schools. Chronic absenteeism is also high, at 40%, but did decrease by 7% from the previous year.
