## DATA SUMMARY

Serving one of the largest student populations of the 12 clusters in Nashville, the Antioch cluster accounts for 9.5% of all MNPS students. It is the only zone with zero public charter and non-zoned school options. Every school scores below the state average for student achievement in both English and Math.

Antioch High School has a strong graduation rate; but only 21% of graduates are considered college or career ready. From middle to high school, the chronic absenteeism and suspension rates almost double and enrollment drops by nearly half between elementary and middle school.

**% Ready Graduate**

The state of Tennessee identifies a Ready Graduate as a student who graduated on time and earned a composite ACT score of a 21 or higher, the score at which students are considered career and college ready.

**Chronic Absenteeism**

Students missing at least 10% of school days (18 days).
