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DATA SUMMARY

In the Glenclyff cluster, every school falls below the state average in English and Math achievement. Glenclyff High School has the lowest graduation rate in MNPS at 68%, and fewer than 16% of graduates are considered college or career ready. Almost 34% of students attending this high school are chronically absent, and 53% are economically disadvantaged.

Within the cluster, student enrollment drops by almost half between elementary and middle school. English Language Learner students comprise nearly half of the cluster's student population (43%), the largest percentage found in any cluster.

% for English and Math represent the number of students scoring "on track" or "mastered." Schools that fell below the TN state average (35% for English and 37% for Math) are in red and those exceeding the state average are in green.
