## DATA SUMMARY

The Hillsboro cluster is home to the district's highest-performing zoned schools, with all middle and elementary school's achievement scores exceeding the state average. JT Moore and West End are the only zoned middle schools in MNPS to meet or exceed the statewide achievement average. Still, the cluster sees enrollment drop by half as students advance from elementary to middle.

Hillsboro High is the highest performing zoned high school in Nashville, and also has the highest graduation rate. Even so, 24% of its students are chronically absent, less than half of graduates are considered college or career ready, and average ACT scores are below what is considered college or career ready (21).
