## DATA SUMMARY

Ranking second in performance amongst all MNPS clusters, the Hillwood cluster includes three Reward elementary schools, two of the highest-performing MNPS traditional middle schools, and a zoned high school with the second-highest Ready Graduate rate in the district.

However, more than one-third of Hillwood's elementary students do not move on to the local zoned middle schools. Middle school achievement scores fall below the state average, and less than half of high schoolers are considered college or career ready. At Hillwood High, fewer than 1 in 10 students are "on track" in Math. Teacher retention in the school dropped significantly in one year, from 93.6\% in 2017-18 to 72.8\% in 2018-19.
