## DATA SUMMARY

Ranking second in performance amongst all MNPS clusters, the Hillwood cluster includes three Reward elementary schools, two of the highest-performing MNPS traditional middle schools, and a zoned high school with the second-highest Ready Graduate rate in the district.

However, more than one-third of Hillwood's elementary students do not move on to the local zoned middle schools. Middle school achievement scores fall below the state average, and less than half of high schoolers are considered college or career ready. At Hillwood High, fewer than 1 in 10 students are "on track" in Math. Teacher retention in the school dropped significantly in one year, from 93.6% in 2017-18 to 72.8% in 2018-19.

## KEY

Reward School

Identified by the state as improving student achievement and growth. The top distinction a school can earn in TN.

Priority School

Identified by the state and fall in the bottom five percent statewide over the past three years, and in need of the most support and improvement.

% Ready Graduate

The state of Tennessee identifies a Ready Graduate as a student who graduated on time and earned a composite ACT score of a 21 or higher, the score at which students are considered career and college ready.

Chronic Absenteeism

Students missing at least 10% of school days (18 days).
