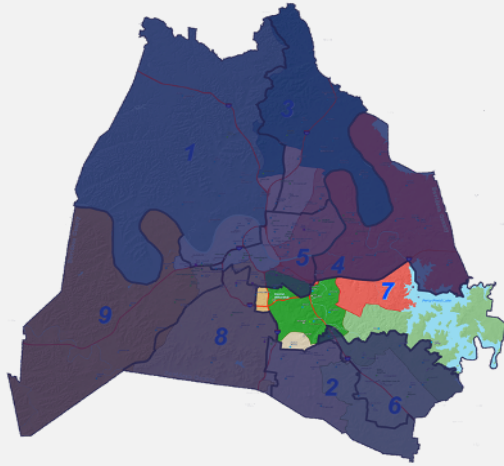

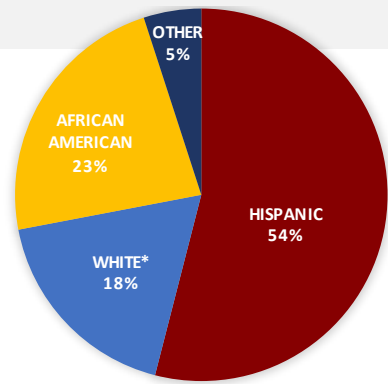

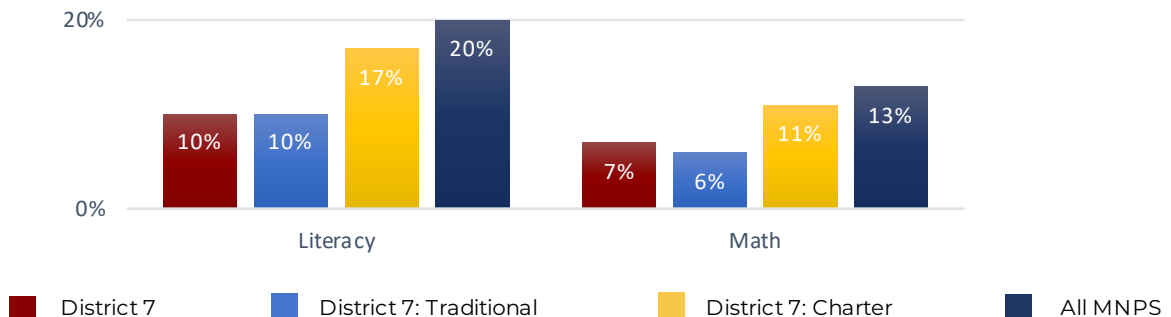

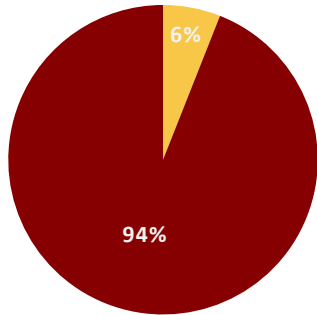
Achievement Scores

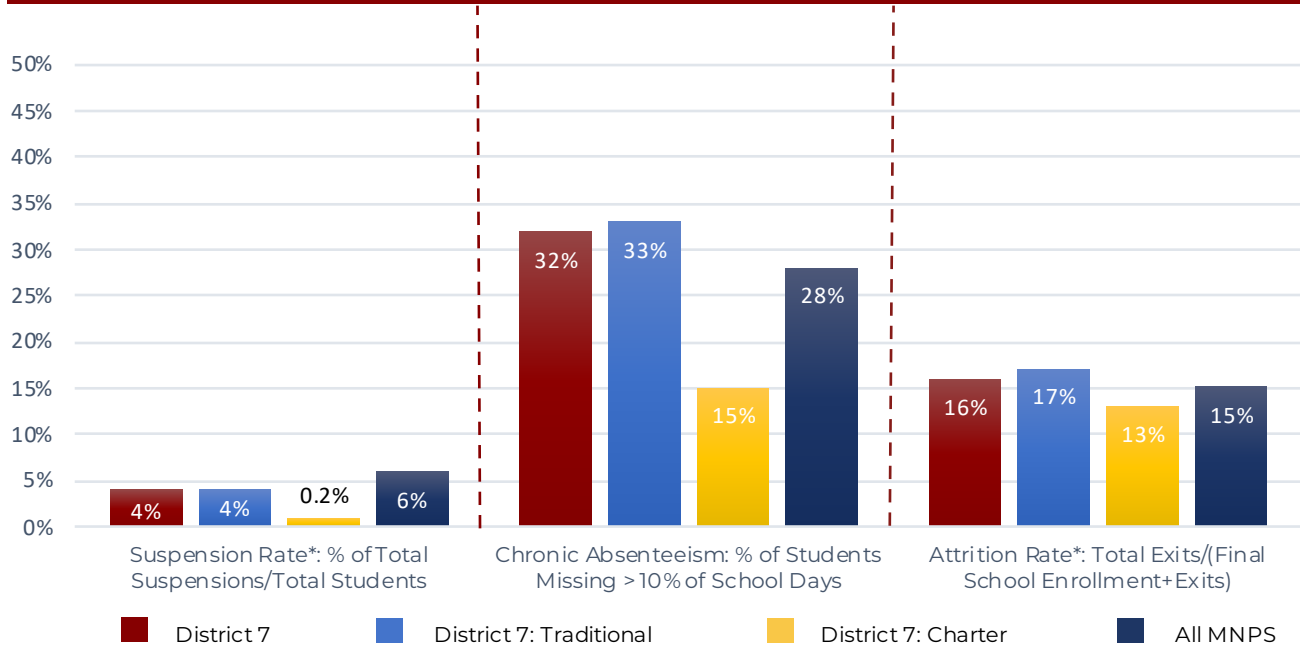
