DATA SUMMARY

Due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on both the 2019/2020 and 2020/2021 school years, MNPS has seen a significant reduction in the percentage of students scoring "on track" or "mastered" in nearly every school.

Serving one of the largest student populations of the 12 clusters in Nashville, the Antioch cluster accounts for 9.3% of all MNPS students. It is the only cluster with zero public charter and non-zoned school options. Antioch High School has a strong graduation rate; but only 17% of graduates are considered college or career ready.
