## DATA SUMMARY

Due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on both the 2019/2020 and 2020/2021 school years, MNPS has seen a significant reduction in the percentage of students scoring "on track" or "mastered" in nearly every school.

Every school in the Cane Ridge cluster scores below the state average for student achievement in both English and Math and student enrollment drops by nearly half between elementary school and middle school. English Language Learners comprise over $40 \%$ of the cluster's student population. While the high school graduation rate is $81 \%$, subject proficiency rates measure 8\% in English and less than 5\% in Math.
