DATA SUMMARY

Due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on both the 2019/2020 and 2020/2021 school years, MNPS has seen a significant reduction in the percentage of students scoring "on track" or "mastered" in nearly every school.

The Hillsboro cluster is home to the district's highest-performing zoned schools, with achievement scores in all elementary schools exceeding the state average. JT Moore is the only zoned middle school in MNPS to meet or exceed the statewide achievement average. Hillsboro High ranks at the top of the district in academic performance and in graduation rate; but only half of its graduates are considered college or career ready.
