
MNPS ZONED FEEDER PATTERN PROFILES (2020-2021): Pearl-Cohn Cluster

The state of Tennessee identifies a Ready Graduate as a student who graduated on time and earned a composite ACT score of a 21 or higher, the score at which students are considered career and college ready.

Chronic Absenteeism Students missing at least 10% of school days (18 days).

English & Math: % for English and Math represent the number of students scoring "on track" or "mastered." Schools that fell below the TN state < 30% > 26% average (30% for English and 26% for Math) are in red and those exceeding the state average are in green.
