DATA SUMMARY

Due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on both the 2019/2020 and 2020/2021 school years, MNPS has seen a significant reduction in the percentage of students scoring "on track" or "mastered" in nearly every school.

No zoned school in this cluster meets the state average for student achievement, and both middle schools and one of the elementary schools score under 5% in mastery of both English and Math. While chronic absenteeism is a concern across all MNPS schools, the Pearl-Cohn cluster has a rate of chronic absenteeism nearing 50% at the elementary school level. At Pearl-Cohn High School, fewer than 10% of students are considered college or career ready. This cluster serves the highest percentage of economically disadvantaged students of all clusters.
