DATA SUMMARY

Due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on both the 2019/2020 and 2020/2021 school years, MNPS has seen a significant reduction in the percentage of students scoring "on track" or "mastered" in nearly every school.

While the Stratford cluster includes one of the highest-performing zoned elementary schools in the district, most schools in the cluster perform well below the state average. Stratford STEM Magnet, a combined high/middle school, has a graduation rate of 76%, but only 19% of graduates are considered college or career ready. Average proficiency rates for English and Math are less than 10%. The school also has one of the highest rates of chronic absenteeism in the district at 65%.
