DATA SUMMARY

Due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on both the 2019/2020 and 2020/2021 school years, MNPS has seen a significant reduction in the percentage of students scoring "on track" or "mastered" in nearly every school.

While Joelton Elementary stands out with achievement scores nearing the state average, most other zoned feeder schools in the cluster have achievement scores under 5% in both English and Math. Whites Creek High School boasts a graduation rate of 83%, but only 16% of its graduates are considered college or career ready. Almost 69% of the student population of the Whites Creek Cluster are economically disadvantaged.
