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DATA SUMMARY

Serving one of the largest student populations of all 12 clusters in Nashville, the Antioch cluster accounts for 5% of all MNPS students. It is the only zone with zero public charter and non-zoned school options. Every school except one scores below the state average for student achievement in both English and Math.

Antioch High School has a strong graduation rate; but only 14% of students are considered college or career ready. From middle to high school, the chronic absenteeism rate almost doubles and the suspension rate more than doubles.

Identified by the state and fall in the bottom five percent statewide over the past three years, and are in need of the most support and improvement.

% Ready Graduate

The state of Tennessee identifies a Ready Graduate as a student who graduated on time in 2017 and earned a composite ACT score of a 21 or higher, the score at which students are considered career and college ready.
