DATA SUMMARY

In this cluster, only 14% of the students are considered college or career ready. Proficiency rates are even lower—7% in English and less than 5% in math. Every school but one scores below the state average for student achievement in both English and Math. Cane Ridge Elementary School has more students than any other elementary or middle school in the district, and 25% of teachers leave every year. Antioch Middle is a Priority school, with achievement rates at only half of its feeder elementary schools. Amongst Cane Ridge Cluster schools, chronic absenteeism rates almost double from middle to high school.
